Question:

Is it the intent of Section 2410 to require impact- resistant glazing in walls of buildings that are located more than a mile from the windborne debris region? [There appears to be some confusion as to whether the glazing in a school building in Niceville, Florida has to be impact- resistant or not. The facility is located more than a mile from the Gulf coast. Figure 1606 (Wind-borne Debris Region Map) shows the windborne debris region in Northwest Florida as being within one mile of the coast.]
