# **Question:**

Is it the intent of Florida Building Code - Plumbing Section 405.3.1 to classify a shower curb as an obstruction when considering the 15" clearance required from the center line of a water closet to an obstruction or does this apply only to objects such as vanities, walls or tub and shower enclosures?

#### **Answer:**

Yes. A shower curb is indeed an obstruction, which would affect both the standing and seated stance of the water closet user. It may also affect wheelchair access to the fixture.
