Question:

Is it the intent of the Code to permit a Special Inspector to perform his duties under the direct supervision of the designated Building Official.

Answer

The special inspector who is licensed under FS 471 or FS481 works for and is directly supervised by the company hired by the owner but the special inspector is accountable to, and must file his inspection reports to the Building Official.
