Question:

Is it the intent of 107.3.4.3 to allow a cert. building contractor to certify the wind loads on residential plans in any circumstance with the equivalence of a design prof.

Answer

Yes, provided the Division I certificate holder or registrant has completed specialized continuing education approved by the CILB per Ch. 489.115(4)(b)2 F.S.

Commentary:

As a reminder - Inside the HVHZ, an architect or engineers seal is required on any single-family residence costing \$10,000 or over.
