## **Question:**

Is it the intent of Section R302.11 to require fireblocking, both vert. and horiz. for 3/4" furring strips installed on the face of concrete block walls to be cover with drywall?

### **Answer:**

# **Commentary:**

Note that R302.11.1 lists 8 options for the fireblocking material. None of these is a 3/4" furring strip.

The first line of the section states states: "In combustible construction..." It goes on to say "Fireblocking shall be provided in wood-frame construction"
